

Data Protection




2 Installation

- 1. Prepare for the installation tools, check the components, and prepare for the installation base.
- 2. Drill holes on the ground according to the installation holes on the pedestals and insert the expansion sleeves.
- 3. According to the entrance and exit marks on the pedestals, move the pedestals to the position.
- 4. Seal the bottom of the turnstile to avoid water from entering.
- 5. Secure the pedestals with expansion bolts.




If the installation area is close to the wall, make sure the distance between the pedestal (without face recognition terminal) and the wall should be more than 25mm (100 mm for pedestal with face recognition terminal), or you cannot open the pedestal's top panel.




4 Wiring Diagram

- You will need to prepare the 14AWG power cable to connect the AC power input to power supply.
- The fire alarm module and face recognition module use the same grounding interface.
- Gate opens at the entrance/exit: connect to BTN1/BTN2 and GND.
- The two 12 V power output interfaces are the power supply for face recognition modules, which is only supported by the models with switching power supply.
- For models with power adapter, the power supply for face recognition modules is not contained in package.

Turnstile with Switching Power Supply




Turnstile with Power Adapter


Level-1 Menu

If the decimal point on the right is on, it indicates the level-1 menu. The number represents the configuration item number.


Level-2 Menu
